Won't you make plans to attend a zone event or rally to reconnect with sisters in Christ and be refreshed and re-focused? Look for the schedule of zone events on page 5.



### Are you thirsty?

For those living in the arid west, water is life. Where water is plentiful, plants grow in abundance. But where water is scarce, or when drought leaves the land dry and parched, the plants shrivel and the land burns up. The land thirsts for water.

### Are you thirsty?

So it is with our lives as Christians. So often, we find ourselves thirsting for more. Thirsting for job security, for health, for wellness; thirsting for friends and family to love and support us; thirsting for meaning in our relationships and in our lives. Thirsting, without even knowing what we're thirsting for.

In John 4, we read about a woman who was thirsting. Her life was a mess of divorce and adultery. She was alone at the well, in the middle of the day to avoid other people, searching for water to quench her thirst. She was searching, until Jesus came to her, offering her a water to quench even the deepest thirst.

[Jesus said,] "Whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." John 4:14

The woman heard the word and believed. That water of life, which only Jesus could give, became in her a spring of water, covering her sins - yes! even those sins which only she knew - and granting her eternal life. So the woman went into town, telling everyone she saw about this Jesus, the man who gave her living water. (John 4:28-29)

### Are you thirsty?

Jesus came to the woman at the well, giving her a water to quench all thirst.

Seeing our thirst and seeing our sin, our Savior stretched Himself out upon the cross to pour out that living water upon us. Through His death and resurrection, He has washed us clean of all our sins, and granted us everlasting life. Our thirst is quenched as water and Word become a raging flood of forgiveness at the Baptismal font.

Are you thirsty? Like the woman at the well, we've been quenched. And like her, we share the good news with others, that Jesus gives us water which leads to eternal life.

Water is life. And through Jesus, we have it in abundance.

### Lutheran Valley Retreat – Fostering Faith in the Forest

Fostering Faith in the Forest, recently funded Mission Grant #13, will use the funding provided to help young people learn of God's incredible love for them. Angela Johnson of Lutheran Valley Retreat writes that, LVR partners with King's Team based in Aurora, CO to bring teenage foster children to camp. On paper, these young people should have nothing to be happy about. One young man had been placed in foster care due to parental abuse and was removed from the first placement in a foster home due to abuse he received from the foster parents. Yet, he was able to smile while playing volleyball at camp. During daily devotions by LVR staff, he heard of the merciful Father who loves him unconditionally. And we as *Lutheran Women in Mission* pray that the Word of God takes root and grows in the heart of this young man and others like him who do not know the Lord.

Last summer 40 students and 20 volunteer chaperones came to LVR for a week in God's creation. Some of these same children will return for another week of camp this summer. Many of the same chaperones and counselors will strengthen their relationships with the teens as they play games and praise our Father in heaven. Angela thanks the LWML for the gifts given to keep camp fees as low as possible for the purpose of giving these precious youth a week at camp where again they will be exposed to the love of Christ through the beauty of God's creation, loving counselors and chaperones and the mighty Word of God. Please pray for God to bless the recipients of this mission grant.
